

**Regular Town Board Meeting Minutes**  
**Tuesday, March 10, 2026**  
**Community Center, immediately following the Public Hearing which started**  
**at 5:00 p.m.**

Chairman Cushing called the meeting to order and noted that it was posted, published, and handicapped accessible in accordance with Wisconsin Open Meeting Laws. A moment of silence was observed to honor our troops here and abroad. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Present: Chairman Cushing, Supervisor Fuhrman, Supervisor Verdoorn, and Clerk Myshchyshyn. Treasurer Murdoff was away.

Motion by Fuhrman, second by Verdoorn to approve the agenda as read. Motion carried.

Motion by Verdoorn, second by Fuhrman to approve the minutes from February 5, 2026, regular board meeting minutes as posted. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report. There was no treasurer's report as the Treasurer was out of town.

Messages/Announcements/Correspondence/Bid Submissions: Building permits were reviewed.

Public Input – taken during the meeting.

1. Town crew maintenance report – Scott Pockat – The crew have been scaping roads of ice. They have used 762 tons of salt/sand but feel that they have enough left to make it through the season. Road signs are being updated. Truck #4's underbody has loosened up and the crew fixed it. They have also been working on Fire Department Brush Truck. There are continued parking issues for lake access and the DNR and sheriff being called regularly. Mostly they seem to be residents who do not like their lakes having public access. Road limits have not been set yet.
2. Plan Commission met on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. Present were Jeff Schlecht, Rich Knoebel, Andy Blaser and Matt Carothers. Also present was Jeff Verdoorn. A motion by Knoebel, second by Schlecht to defer action on three sign applications submitted by Brandon Newman, applicant and registered agent of the Hwy 51 Safe Storage LLC, on the following described property: Lot 3, CSM 5434, being part of the SE ¼, NE ¼, Section 22, T38N, R6E, PIN HA-297 Town of Hazelhurst. Carothers abstained, motion carried. The Plan Commission also reviewed a courtesy submission survey by McMullen & Associates, Inc., Benton McMullen, surveyor on a lot adjustment between Lot 1 of CSM #2464 and the parcel described as Government Lot 2, Section 10, T38N, R6E, Town of Hazelhurst. Knoebel would like to review the sign ordinance and Carothers would like a review and revision of the Comprehensive Plan timeframe. Next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 7, 2026, 10:00 a.m.
3. No action was taken on the sign application referenced in item #2 above.
4. Town Board reviewed the preliminary survey submitted by McMullen & Associates, Inc., Benton McMullen, surveyor on a lot adjustment between Lot 1 of CSM #2464 and the parcel described as Government Lot 2, Section 10, T38N, R6E, Town of Hazelhurst.
5. Motion by Verdoorn, second by Fuhrman to approve Resolution 26-02 supporting a comprehensive and sustainable transportation funding solution. Motion carried.
6. Motion by Fuhrman, second by Cushing to approve the DNR beaver contract for 2026. Motion carried.
7. Clerk Myshchyshyn discussed preliminary procedures needed to vacate Curtis Road which runs between Minocqua Road and Lakeview Street/Woodson Street. A resolution needs to be drawn up by the town's attorney, passed by the town board and then submitted to Oneida County.
8. Town Board review the ATV/UTV ordinance. There have been no complaints. Rich Knoebel requested an ATV/UTV speed limit sign put up at Berrend Rd.
9. Chairman Cushing reminded everyone of the Annual Meeting scheduled for Tuesday, April 21, 2026, 5:00 p.m., at the Hazelhurst Community Center.
10. Motion by Cushing, second by Verdoorn to approve the payment of bills. Motion carried.
