- 1. Town crew maintenance report Matt Strasburg The crew has been working on the shoulders before the Wildwood Dr road project and crackfill project. The docks and picnic tables have been put away and the well blown out. The trapper is finished for the season. There was beaver damage on Kitty Creek culvert which took some time for the crew to clean up. The 400 tons of Salt/Sand was delivered. The town has an additional 200 tons stored in Minocqua. The crew is working on some minor repairs to the trucks and the plows are ready for winter. No word yet on when the crackfill will start.
- 2. Plan Commission did not meet.
- 3. Second reading of Ordinance 25-01, which restricts certain artificial wake enhancements which apply to three lakes, Hughitt Lake, McCormick Lake and Bearskin Lake, which borders are shared with the Town of Cassian and the Town of Lake Tomahawk.
